Shortened Day - Friday 9th September

Next Friday is the opening day for the 2011 Rugby World Cup. Due to staff having a 2-hour professional development session on restorative practices from 8:00am to 10:00am, classes commence at 10:00am.

Property Development

We are currently finalising our property agreement with the Ministry of Education. We propose the following developments over the next couple of years:

- From the beginning of 2012, we will be hosting a class from the Wilson Home and one from the Wairau Valley Special School. This will involve modifications and modernisation of spaces in our top block, C Block. Our own Special Needs area will also move into this block, into modernised rooms. Their current rooms will be removed.
- Our Science Department will be brought closer together in A Block and the laboratories in rooms 13, 14, 74 and 75 will be upgraded. We are hoping to have a Senior Science projects room and Digital Data collection room included in this project.
- The room behind the Library will be included in the Library through glass panels and doors to provide a more comprehensive computer hub in our Library.
- A set of mothballed changing rooms in the gymnasium will be renovated back to life to help us better accommodate visiting sports teams and PE classes.
- We have secured Lion Foundation funding to move a prefabricated classroom from our cluster of Community
 Education rooms up next to our Whare kai and to convert it into a Whare by recladding it to match the Whare kai and
 putting a veranda on the front with new doors in place. This will be the next stage in a project commenced back in the
 1990s with the final stage being the decoration or dressing up of our Whare to reflect our place and its history.

These projects will enable us to continue to provide excellent facilities to those lucky enough to come to our school. We certainly look forward to seeing it all happen.

This is our biennial gathering of a huge range of tertiary training providers and even employers who will be here that evening to provide information to students and parents on possible courses and pathways beyond school.
