Choosing a course for 2013

Students in Years 10 to 12 have all had the opportunity to discuss their best course for 2013 with their Tutor Teacher, with you and with a Dean or Senior Manager at the Academic Interviews. While some students may have been a little disappointed at not being able to advance as they had hoped at this stage, there is the opportunity to prove what they can do in the national external exams that are coming up in mid-November for most of these students. Decisions about courses for next year have been made on the basis of what a student has achieved to date and a prediction about what they might achieve in their remaining internal assessments and national exams based on effort, attitude and achievement to date and the results of their practice exams. However, if any disappointment over missing out on a subject galvanises a student into action and study and much improved results in national exams, then a course selection can be changed. It's time to get stuck in!

Study planner

All senior students have had the opportunity to uplift a study planner from their Tutor Teacher which has a full page for each week remaining in their school year showing each day divided into morning, afternoon and evening. They have also been given a "How to Study" guide and the timetable for the national examinations. The intention is that all senior students who are faced with national exams can plan ahead what they will study and for how much time day by day, subject by subject, right up till the end of the exams. They are effectively making a contract with themselves. Ask to see this planner. Ensure that it is displayed in a prominent place and check that your child is honouring it.
