In other staff changes, **Karl Lee** who joined us in Term 4 last year from Rangitoto College is now Head of English. **Helen Drabble**, our Head of International Languages, is now also our Specialist Classroom Teacher and E-Dean.

While I have been on the job for the past two weeks welcoming people back and helping to get the year up and running, I am on leave for the remainder of this term. Principals are entitled to sabbatical leave every five years, a chance for refreshment and professional research and learning. **Mr Dave Bagwell** is Acting Principal in my absence and I return in Term 2.

The 2013 NCEA results were very pleasing. Pass rates at Levels 1 to 3 of NCEA were 70% or better at each level and most pleasing were the level endorsements. At Level 1, more than half the students who passed achieved a Merit or Excellence Endorsement. Endorsements at Levels 2 and 3 were also the best yet. Of note were Ysabel Escandor at Level 2 and Monica Sayani at Level 1 who bettered 100 Excellence Credits each. These are outstanding results and testimony to the fact that while we work very hard to get as many students as possible through NCEA, we do not ignore those at the very top.

Renovations to the Library and Gymnasium were completed late last year. The Library has now been enlarged into the room behind to form one large space providing additional room for computer access, quiet study areas and reading spaces. Previously mothballed changing rooms in the gymnasium have been completely renovated to provide additional space for classes, the Services Academy and visiting teams to change in. We have been fortunate over recent years to be able to renovate significant parts of our school to provide excellent facilities for all.
