

YEAR 9 START OF YEAR – TUESDAY, 30th JANUARY 2024

Welcome to Glenfield College and to our school community for the 2024 school year and beyond. We look forward to working with you over the years ahead in the on-going education of your child. This letter is to inform you of important dates for the start of 2024.

The 2024 school year commences on Tuesday, 30th January for all new students. Students will need to be at school by 8.45am and assemble in the front carpark where they will meet with the Year 9 Dean. The day will commence at 9am with a Powhiri at the school Marae for all new students and new staff. Parents/caregivers/siblings are also invited. Students will have orientation for the rest of the morning with their class and peer support leaders and will receive their timetables on this day. School will finish at 3.10pm on this day.

Please be reminded that all students in Years 9 to 13 must be in correct uniform (Years 9 to 10 in junior uniform, and Years 11 to 13 in senior uniform). Our uniform is available for purchase at New Zealand Uniforms. Our secondhand uniform shop is also open every school day this year between 8.30am and 4pm (ask at the main reception for directions) until Tuesday, 5 December 2023 and will be open in 2024 between 9am & 3pm on Wednesday 24th, Thursday 25th and between 9am and 12pm on Friday 26th January 2024. Please note that our stock of second-hand uniform is limited.

The first day of the timetable for 2024 is Wednesday, 31st January (Day 3) and all students should be at school by **9.45am** for a full day of classes finishing at **3.10pm**.

Year 9 students require a laptop. Please see the information included in the "Starting at Glenfield College 2024" booklet.

Basic stationery is required on the first day of school and further stationery should be purchased once students have their timetables and know what option choices they will be studying.
