- Learn acting techniques
- Create, rehearse & perform

- Learn dance movement from different genres
- Choreograph movement in groups
- Develop & improve dance technique

- Build teamwork and communication skills
- Learn about food, nutrition and healthy choices

- Technical drawing skills
- Design your own tiny home
- Creative problem solving

- Workshop safety and tools

- Create your own metal drill jig
